REOPENING OF THE COLLEGE FOR OFFLINE CLASSES :-

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- (1) Wearing a mask is mandatory to enter the campus of the college. In no event will students having symptoms such as fever, cough and cold be allowed to enter the campus.
