Sub: Recognition of Colleges in terms of the Regulations framed under Section 2(f) of the U.G.C. Act read with Section 26(1)(d) of the U.G.C. Act 1956.

Sir/Madam,

I am forwarding herewith a copy each of the letters No.F.33-34/65(CD) Pt.II, dated 1.9.71, No. F.33-34/65(CD)Pt.II dated 6.11.71 and No.F.13-14/71(CD) dated 8.11.71 received from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, on the subject mentioned above, for your information and necessary action.

In this connection, I am to invite your attention to the sub-clause (iii) cited in the Commission's letter dated 1.9.71 and to the 1st paragraph of the Commission's letter dated 8.11.71 and to request you to be so good as to state if your College satisfies the requirements of the sub-clause (iii) and if so, furnish this office with the attested copies of the relevant documents, in duplicate.

In case your College does not satisfy the requirements, steps may kindly be taken to have it done within the stipulated period of 3 years i.e. before 1.9.74 and the fact reported to this office with the attested copies of the relevant documents, in duplicate.

I am also to request you to furnish this office, in duplicate, with information on the following points immediately, in order to enable this office to examine the present position of your College in this regard :

1. Is the College registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) ?
2. Is the College a body corporate established or incorporated under a Central or State Act for the time being in force ?
3. Is the College a trust with trustees being appointed and vested with legal powers and duties ?

Sub: Recognition of Colleges in terms of the Regulations framed under section 2(f) of the UGC Act read with Section 26(1) (d) of the UGC Act 1956.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to this Office letter No. F.33-34/65(CD)Pt.II dated 1.9.1971 on the above subject and to say para (iii) of the regulations it is required that the college should be entered as a Society under the Societies registration Act 1860 (21 of 1860) a body corporate established or incorporated under a Central or State Act the time being in force or is a trust with trustees being appointed and with legal powers and duties. It has been observed from the communication received from the colleges regarding their legal entity that the Managing Committees of the Colleges/Institutions are registered in their own name and not Colleges.

It is requested that the University, while sending fresh proposals the inclusion of colleges or information in respect of old Colleges may see the college has a legal entity of its own as required in para (iii) of the regulations and not the managing body of the college. The requisite information in respect of old colleges may please be collected by the Universities and consolidated statement sent to the Commission for consideration and record. Colleges may be informed not to send the information direct to U.G.C.

Subject: Recognition of colleges in terms of the regulations framed under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act read with Section 23(1) of the UGC Act 1956.

Sir,

I am directed to say that in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 23 of the UGC Act 1956 (3 of 1956) and in supersession of the regulation in force at present for according recognition to institutions under clause (f) of Section 2 of this Act, the University Grants Commission, with the approval of the Central Government has made the following regulations:-

"Recognition of Institutions:

- (1) The Commission may, in consultation with the University concerned, recognise, for purposes of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, an institution as a University, if -
 - (i) it is affiliated to, or forms a constituent member of, or is run directly as a university college by, a university established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act and the statutes and regulations made thereunder;
 - (ii) it provides instructions upto a Bachelor's Degree or upto a post-graduate Degree or for a post-graduate Degree only or provides instructions for a Diploma Course of a duration of not less than one academic year and for which the minimum qualification for admission is a Bachelor's Degree; and
 - (iii) it is registered as a society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or is a body corporate established or incorporated under a Central or State Act for the time being in force or is a trust with trustees being appointed and vested with legal powers and duties, any institution, recognised by the Commission under clause (f) of Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, immediately before the commencement of these regulations shall, if it does not satisfy the requirements of clause (iii) of sub-regulation (1), take action to comply with such requirements within a period of three years of such commencement."

The above regulations, would come into force with effect from 1.9.1971.

It is requested that the University, while sending proposals for the inclusion of affiliated colleges in the list of colleges prepared under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, may also send documentary evidence to the effect that the College/Institution is registered as a Society, under the Societies Registration Act 1860 (21 of 1860) or is a body corporate established or incorporated under the Central or State Act for the time being in force or is a trust, the trustees being appointed and vested with legal powers and duties. The proforma in which the particulars of the college are to be sent has been suitably amended to incorporate the above and a copy of the same is attached for reference.

With regard to the colleges already on the list prepared under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, as would be evident from the revised regulations, a period of 3 years has been provided for such colleges which do not satisfy the requirements of sub-clause (iii) for compliance with the revised regulations. It is also requested that the University may examine the position of the affiliated colleges which do not satisfy the requirements of sub-clause (iii) and ensure that they conform to the regulations within the stipulated period. The details of such colleges may please be communicated to the Commission at a very early date.
