Report:

Agriculture is not only largest livelihood provider in India but also contributes a significant figure to the Gross Domestic Product. Although Indian agriculture and allied activities have witnessed different revolutions but one of the most important factors responsible for reduced yield and stunted plant growth is the deteriorated soil. Urgent measures should be taken to arrest the degradation process and to restore fertility and productivity of problematic soils. It is not possible to recover soil fertility and productivity without soil conservation techniques.

Soil conservation entails using a variety of methods and techniques to maintain the quality of soil. Soil conservationists work to keep soil rich and productive while also protecting it from erosion and decay. Soil conservation can aid in the reduction of food insecurity and the promotion of healthy communities. Soil also contributes to a cleaner environment by absorbing around a third of the carbon dioxide produced by fossil fuels and industrial processes.

By looking into the major problem of deteriorated soils of the nearby villages the NSS unit of the college along with the students arranged a campaign to create awareness regarding Soil Conservation on 7th December, 2022 among the students of Vidyanagar Multipurpose School (Boys). The primary objective was to encourage students for acquiring adequate knowledge on soil testing techniques, Soil Management strategies which they can distribute further in their locality thereby creating awareness about the importance and benefits of the healthy ecosystem. The third year students of B.Sc. (Hons.) Zoology participated with great zeal and enthusiasm along with the faculty members and explained the soil type of the region and the methods for conserving soil, to the students. The students of the college interacted with students of the school and discussed in detail the necessary reclamation procedures for soil conservation as the soil found in that area was loamy soil. The school students also discussed their soil related knowledge with them which in turn added to their information. 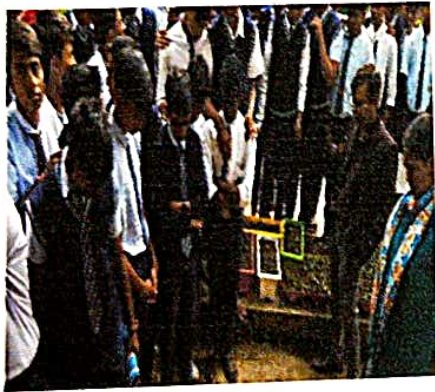
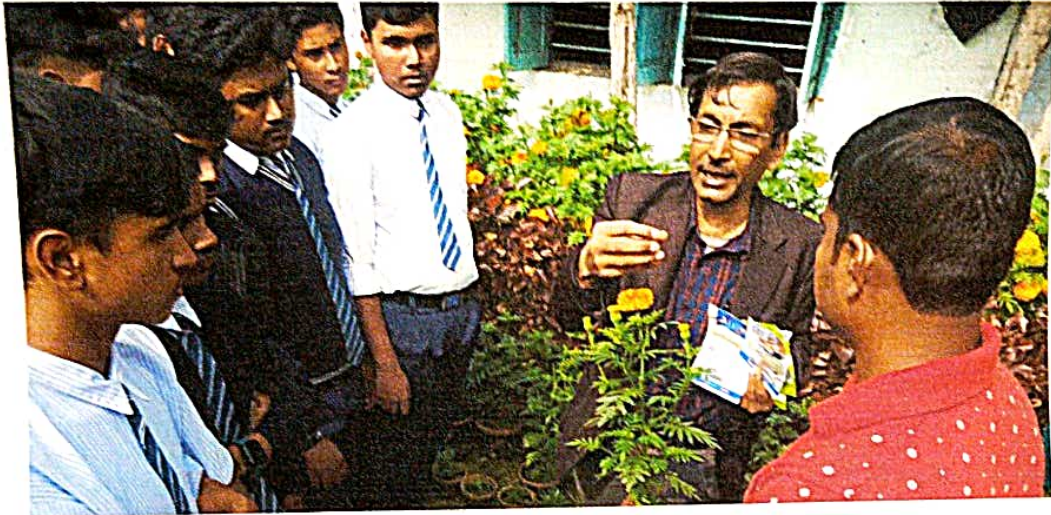
